

LEVERETT MEMBERS OF THE ARMY OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC
1861-1865

Most were privates, most were de-mobbed at the end of the War against the South, a few died in battle. At least one in the notorious Andersonville prison in Georgia.

This list does not include those who began as officers. Officers then were not enlistees or draftees. They were appointed through political connections.

A Company is usually about 100 plus its officers.

A Regiment is usually about 10 Companies, so around 1,000. During the Civil War Regiments depleted in battle weren't usually replenished, new Regiments were created.

4 Regiments is a Brigade, so around 4,000.

1 Division is 4 Brigades, around 16,000.

1 Corps is 2 or 3 Divisions, so 32, or 48,000.

Grant as Leut. General of all Federal forces in 1864-5 was running three Corps, approaching 150,000, plus Artillery and Cavalry, in Virginia trying to get between Lee and Richmond, the Capitol of the Confederacy.
